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The *Journal of Ancient Egyptian Interconnections* (JAEI) is an online scholarly publication integrating Egyptian archaeology with Mediterranean, Near Eastern, and African studies—providing a dedicated venue for this growing field of interdisciplinary and inter-area research. The journal has a wide geographical and temporal range while continuing to specialize in all aspects of interaction between ancient Egypt and its neighbors. This extends to environmental, reception, and other types of studies, including the application of new methodologies, the history of Egyptology, the development and curation of Egyptian collections, “Egyptomania,” and broadly related topics.

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
